Expectations:

People **MUST** stay in their cars

Two services - 8:00 am & 10:30 am

Zoom social hour @ 9:00 am

Services will be approx. 45 minutes or less

No admittance to the church building – bathrooms are **NOT** available

Online worship will continue for those not comfortable in joining us in the parking lot

In case of inclement weather including, but not limited to heavy rain, lightning, snow (this is Michigan!), temperature below 50 degrees, high winds worship will be cancelled. Announcement will be on Facebook.


Bulletins will be provided for each person – keep them and recycle them at home. They will include hymns.

GRANT APPROVAL

The Mt. Zion Lutheran Church Foundation has approved St. Paul for a grant totaling \$2,350.00.

There is \$900.00 for our August 20th food truck and \$1450.00 for the new Reading for Life Program at St. Paul. The grant is limited specifically to supplies, instruction resources, and books for the children. Funds are not to be used for student Holiday, end of year gifts, snacks, tutor training, background checks and volunteer appreciation. This grant is made in memory of Mt. Zion Evangelical Lutheran Church, which faithfully ministered to its members and to the community of northeast Detroit for 73 years. It is an expression of the continuing ministry and faith of the former Mt. Zion community.
